ALL ENTRIES IN OPEN JUNIOR DEPARTMENT TO BE RECEIVED AT THE SPUR EMPORIUM (YOUTH BUILDING). Limited to Junior residents of Amador, Calaveras, and El Dorado Counties who are 17 years old and under and Grange members not eligible for entry in other Junior Departments.

NOTE: Each entry in these divisions shall have been made or produced by the exhibitor. Entries shall be entered on Junior Department entry forms provided by the Fair. Parents Signature REQUIRED on ALL forms. The signature of the project supervisor is required if applicable. State and Local rules apply to all entries and Score Card in corresponding Adult and Junior Department divisions shall be used unless otherwise provided in this division.

WILLIAM WINTLE MEMORIAL AWARD

The William Wintle Memorial Award will be awarded to the outstanding young artist. The recipient's name will be added to the William Wintle Memorial Award Perpetual Trophy, which will remain at the Fair Office on display. To be eligible, the artist must be between the ages of 10 years and 17 years, must be a resident of Amador County, and must enter his/her "Original Only" artwork in the Amador County Fair. (Copies of other artists' work are not considered Original).

Only the following art medium will be eligible for competition: Painting - any medium; Pastel, Charcoal, Pencil, Pen & Ink, or any combination thereof. If there is any question as to the validity of the recipient's age, residency, or originality of work, the Fair reserves the right to retain the award until such questions have been validated. If quality is not worthy of the award, it will not be presented. NOTE: Artwork to be considered must be entered in a regular scheduled class with the Art Department, and judging for the William Wintle Award is automatic if entered.

HIGH POINT CASH AWARDS

Vocational Education Farm & Home Equipment Silent Auction

**OPEN to Junior Exhibitors residing in Amador
County ONLY**

Rules:

- A. Only projects made or repaired by the exhibitor during the past school year as part of their Vocational Education and under the supervision of a Vocational Educational Instructor and receiving a first place award are eligible.
- B. Exhibitors may not sell an animal in the Junior Livestock Auction and sell a project in the Farm & Home Equipment Silent Auction.
- C. Medium projects or larger enter entered in Division 702-709 qualify. Look for \$ signs for eligible items.
- D. Exhibit must have a minimum value of \$50 to be accepted into the auction.
- E. An intent to sell declaration form must be submitted with the entry form stating the minimum bid amount accepted if the exhibit qualifies for auction.
- F. A portfolio or display describing the project, cost of supplies, labor hours, minimum bid, and any other pertinent information or pictures must be submitted with the exhibit. The portfolio will be displayed for the duration of the Fair.

- I. Silent auction bids will be accepted concurrent with the Junior Livestock Auction. Highest bidder will be contacted for payment and pick up arrangements.
- J. All exhibitors selling an item in the Farm & Home Equipment Silent Auction will be assessed a charge of 7% of the gross selling price to defray auction sale expenses.

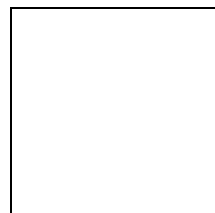
